- 4) **Financial Report:** \$48,086 Reserve, \$23,837 Checking, \$2,967 Savings (Playground). Budget is publically available and posted on the RiekePTA.org website.

YTD: Revenue \$18,706.95, Expenses \$22,244.64, Net Decrease (\$3,537.69)

5) Fundraising Report:

Dining for Dollars: Monday, April 8th. Meals purchased between 4:30pm and close will have 15% of profits go to Rieke. Must present flyers, can be via on phone.

- 6) **Auction Report:** The auction raised \$93,000. Expenses were about \$17,000. Slot parties are open until end of March so final amount will not be determined until after they close.
- 7) **Unfinished Business Update:** Climbing wall has been put on hold for now. School redistricting effort is ongoing. We are currently putting together a committee of people who can attend district Board meetings and then come back to Rieke to report.
- 8) Votes needed:
 - Vote 1: Spirit Wear budget increase of \$121.76. PTA membership approved the increase to our budget.
 - Vote 2: OBOB competition space rental for \$135. PTA membership approved the increase to our budget.
 - Vote 3: Diversity meeting meals for \$500 annual funding. PTA membership approved an add this recurring expense to the 2019-2020 budget.
- 9) **Chess Club Update:** K-5. Mondays, drop in class, 5:30-7pm in library. Includes games, lessons, puzzles, chess books and materials. PTA provides some financial support.
- 10) **Principal Selection:** Kristie Lindholm visited our PTA meeting to obtain feedback about the search for a new principal. After a 60 minute discussion, the priorities that our community listed were:
