2020-2021 Financials

Brennan Ganter took the floor to go over the current account balances.

- Account Balance as of 5/31/2021: \$31,854.01
- Net change year-on-year of (\$16,315.05)
- \$20,000 spending was for one-time budgeted playscape/paving improvements (\$20,000) spent during this school year towards the playscape paving project. Funds have been raised in previous years and there's a remaining balance in the playscape fund to be used to finish the striping project.

School Supplies

Sasha Pollack took the floor to discuss a new school supply program.

- Potential new model for how we buy school supplies
- Opportunity to increase equity and sustainability
- Three major components to program
 - Collect list of needed supplies from teachers
 - End of year glean (from previous year)
 - o PTA bulk purchase share a per student price with families
- Benefits
 - Reduced costs by buying in bulk
 - Saves time for families
 - Reduces stigma and chaos on first day of school
- Families still provide backpacks, lunchboxes, and anything in particular for their student that they
 want

Playscape

Adam Light took the floor to give an update on the playground paving and playscape project.

- Pavement work to widen walkway and reduce puddles is complete
- Design process for striping is underway and implementation will be completed in the summer/fall

- Returning Principal Grant and Art Grant to pre-Covid amounts
- Adjusted fundraisers to match 2019-2020 contributions
- Cancelled online directory, moving to free PTA solution MemberHUB

Motion to allocate \$5,000 for School Supplies Grant to be used for the school supplies project was seconded and approved unanimously.
